NINTH ANNUAL TOUCH-A-TRUCK IS ON SATURDAY, SEPTEMBER 21, 2019

Touch-a-Truck is a community event that offers children of all ages a hands-on opportunity to get behind the wheel of their favorite big rigs. Firetrucks, ambulances, police cars, power line trucks, city buses, tow trucks, and garbage trucks are just some of the exciting vehicles and heavy machinery that will be available for exploration. Join us Saturday, September 21, 2019, from 9:00 AM to 2:00 PM at Spokane Community College, 1810 N Greene Street for the 9th Annual Touch-a-Truck. Tickets are \$5 per person or \$20 max per family. Ages 2 and under are free. Tickets will be sold at the door.

The first 300 children through the door will receive a free book. Other activities at the event include face painting, reading activities, food vendors, and community information booths. Horns are silent throughout the event, except between 1 pm and 2 pm, when kids have the freedom to blare away!

All proceeds from this event will support the Junior League of Spokane's mission and its efforts on improving childhood literacy in the greater Spokane community. Money raised by prior Touch-a-Truck events has helped the Junior League of Spokane create a book bank that provides free books to children in our community, host community book fairs throughout the year and provide book grants to local teachers and community organizations.

Touch-a-Truck began in October of 2011 and continues to grow over the years. Last year, over 2,000 people attended this family-friendly event.
