

BOOK GRANT RECIPIENTS

Advancing childhood literacy is a key focus of our organization and we are thrilled to support organizations in the Spokane region that share in this mission. The 2021 Book Grant gave out a total of \$2,300 to YWCA ECEAP (\$700), Trinity Catholic School (\$400), Bemiss Elementary (\$400), Spokane World Relief (\$400) and Sunset Elementary (\$400). We also awarded books to Shilo Elementary, a Whitworth student teacher and Beautiful Savior Preschool.

BOOK BANK

Established in 2016, the JLS Book Bank is an ongoing effort to solicit funds and book donations to maintain an inventory of new and pristine-condition books for use in literacy efforts by the JLS and its community partners. In 2020-2021, the Book Bank distributed over 960 books in our community through our Book Grants program, the JLS Book Fair and PALS Program.

IMPACT PROJECTS

Despite restrictions on in-person and community gatherings, the women of the Junior League of Spokane donated their collective power in creative ways in 2020-2021. Projects include a drive in collaboration with Project Beauty Share for those affected by the Malden fire, providing popsicles and books to Spokane Police Activities League (PALS), and partnering with Meals on Wheels to write letters to veterans for Veterans Day.

BOOK FAIR

The Junior League of Spokane hosted the 2020 Treasure Hunt Book Fair on Saturday, March 7, 2020, at the West Central Community Center. We created a drive-through experience complete with pirates, special contests and a host of community partners and volunteers. We hosted over 122 children, and over 200 people total. We had 11 community partners in attendance, and 42 JLS members who volunteered their time!

TOUCH-A-TRUCK




