Look-a-Truck is a community event that offers children of all ages an opportunity to see and learn about their favorite big rigs in a safe and fun environment. This year, due to an abundance of caution, we have pivoted to a drive-through event with recorded audio for kids to experience firetrucks, ambulances, police cars, power line trucks, city buses, tow trucks, and garbage trucks and other exciting vehicles and heavy machinery. Join us Saturday, September 25, 2021, from 9:00 AM to 1:00 PM at Spokane Community College, 1810 N Greene Street for this year's Look-a-Truck. There is a suggested donation of \$10 per car. **The first 150 cars will receive a goodie bag.** Participating companies/organizations will be handing out goodies as well.

All proceeds from this event will support the Junior League of Spokane's mission and its efforts on improving childhood literacy in the greater Spokane community. Money raised by prior Touch-a-Truck events has helped the Junior League of Spokane create a book bank that provides free books to children in our community, host community book fairs throughout the year and provide book grants to local teachers and community organizations.

Touch-a-Truck began in October of 2011 and continues to grow over the years. In previous years, over 2,000 people attended this family-friendly event.
