APPLICATIONS ARE OPEN FOR THE JUNIOR LEAGUE OF SPOKANE BOOK GRANTS

SPOKANE, WA, February 14, 2022 - The Junior League of Spokane is now accepting applications for Book Grants. Eligible applicants include local community organizations, non-profits, educational agencies, classrooms, and individuals.

The purpose of these grants is to promote childhood literacy in the Spokane area. Applicants should identify how their request aligns with that purpose; what, if any, historically underserved or underrepresented populations would be supported; as well as any challenges that would be alleviated by receiving a book grant.

Last year alone, the Junior League of Spokane awarded books and more than \$2,300 in grants to local teachers, schools, and community organizations. Past recipients include teachers and schools across the Spokane area, the YWCA, Embrace Washington and Volunteers of America of Eastern Washington & Northern Idaho.
